

Welcome to Medical Student Emergency Abdominal Surgery Course (**sEaSC**). The course is based on the award winning EaSC for registrars / junior consultants. The 1st EaSC was held in Letterkenny Donegal in May 2012 and the most recent in Portugal, Spain, Greece, Brazil and Sri Lanka. The 3rd sEaSC was held in Campinas, Brazil, in Nov 2016, and the 4th in Letterkenny in Jan 2017 and the 5th in Dublin in Mar 2017.

This new student course builds on EaSC success and has been modified to meet the curriculum of medical students. It is an ideal preparation for those who wish to excel on their exams. The first course in 2015 was rated by final meds as the best educational event in their student's curriculum.

World leading courses in Emergency Surgery are developing with ESTES in Europe and MOSES in Australia / New Zealand. None have been pitched for the need of the medical student. sEaSC curriculum focuses on the acute abdomen, in a multidisciplinary shared learning approach. It will bring you a level of discussion you have not sensed before and enhance your knowledge of clinical presentations, symptoms, signs and management. This course is about the patient and common emergencies. It will help, not only with your exams but as a young doctor. It combines theory with practical cases. The cases are real, common and will take you to the patient in the emergency departments, wards, ICU and OR. Over half of the course will involve discussions and explanations.

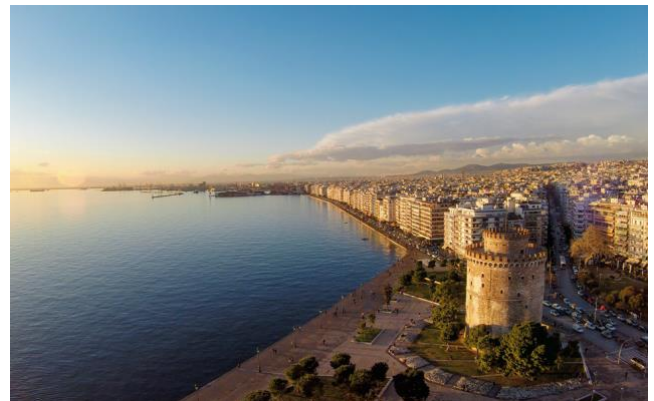
