

Welcome to the new *virtual* **Medical student** Emergency Abdominal Surgery Course (sEASC). This course is based on the award winning EASC for registrars/junior consultants. The first EASC course was held in Letterkenny, Donegal Ireland in May 2012 and has now been run in 10 countries. 15 sEASC courses have now been held in Ireland, Brazil and Greece.

This award winning student course is tailored to curriculum of medical students. It is an ideal preparation for those who wish to excel at their exams. Since the first sEASC course in 2015 it is rated by final meds as one of the best educational events in their student curriculum. It has been modified to a virtual platform because of Covid.

Courses in Emergency Surgery are developing with WSES, ESTES in Europe and MOSES in Australia and New Zealand. None have been pitched for the specific needs of medical students. sEASC curriculum focuses on the acute abdomen, in a multidisciplinary shared learning approach. It brings a level of discussion you have not heard before and will enhance your knowledge of presentations, symptoms, signs and management. This course is about the patient and common emergencies. It will help, not only with your exams but as a young doctor. It combines theory with practical cases. Over half of the course involves discussion between consultants and residents. You can relax and take the two 3 hour sessions in your stride.
