

Welcome to the 14th **Medical student** Emergency Abdominal Surgery Course (**sEASC**). This award winning course is based on the EASC for registrars/junior consultants. The first EASC course was held in Letterkenny, Donegal Ireland in May 2012 and the most recent in Canada, New Zealand, Portugal, Spain, Greece, Brazil and Sri Lanka. sEASC courses have now been held in Ireland, Brazil and Greece.

sEASC is a student course that builds on its success and has been modified to meet the curriculum of medical students. It is an ideal preparation for those who wish to excel at their exams. The first course in 2015 was rated by final meds as the best educational event in their student's curriculum.

World leading courses in Emergency Surgery are developing with ESTES in Europe and MOSES in Australia and New Zealand. None have been pitched for the need of the medical student. sEASC curriculum focuses on the acute abdomen, in a multidisciplinary shared learning approach. It will bring you a level of discussion you have not heard before and enhance your knowledge of presentations, symptoms, signs and management. This course is about the patient and common emergencies. It will help, not only with your exams but as a young doctor. It combines theory with practical cases. The cases are real, common and will take you to the patient in the emergency departments wards, ICU and OR. Over half of the course will involve discussion and explanation. All cases are illustrated with AV.

Course Goals

Understanding the natural history of key emergency abdominal surgery presentations. This coupled with a manual containing lectures and the latest literature references, it will ensure you get optimal exposure to both theory and practice. This course will take your knowledge to the next level.
