This award winning student course is tailored to the curriculum of medical students. It is an ideal preparation for those who wish to excel at their exams. Since the first sEASC course in 2015, it is rated by final meds as one of the best educational event in their student curriculum

Courses in Emergency Surgery are developing with WSES, ESTES in Europe and MOSES in Australia and New Zealand.
